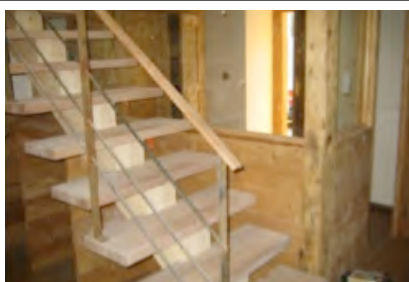
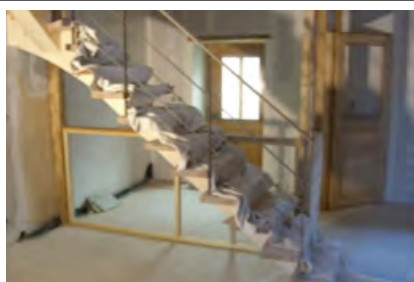


Demolition, gutting, reconstruction and renovation work. 9-month project.

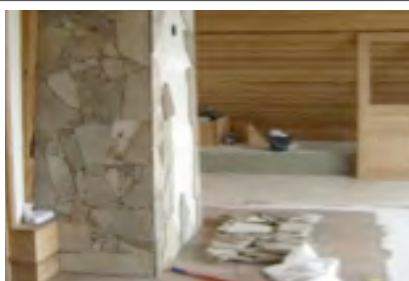
Reroofing and pointing of stonework.

Faux chimney duct stone clad as the backdrop for a woodburner.

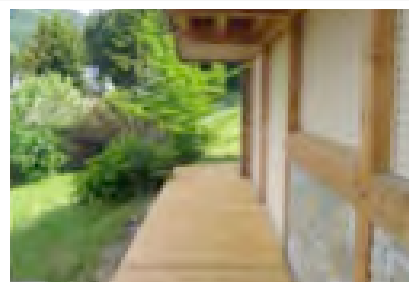

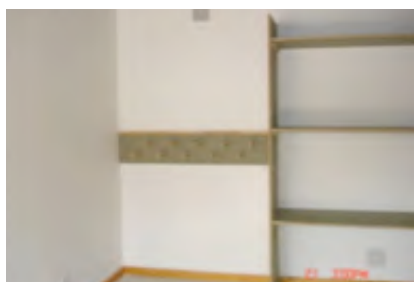

Laying of the foundations and corrugated reinforcements before the pouring of cement in preparation for the liner.



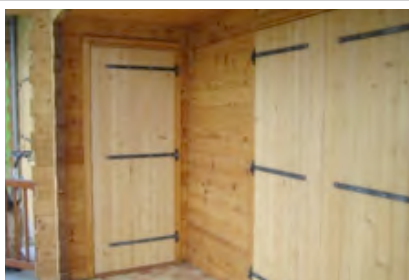

Sandblasting and Wood Treatment



Prior to the start of this project, the property resembled the chalet to the left of the picture – coated with the then fashionable dark brown varnish of the 80's.



After removing all the shutters and doors, the sandblasting of every inch of the entire chalet from top to bottom could start.



The finished result, using a natural wood protection coating commonly used in Scandinavia and Canada.
